

Residuary Legacy Clause Wording

A residuary gift is the **whole or a percentage of what remains of your estate** after all other legacies, once all other gifts and expenses have been paid. These gifts are very important to us because it is expressed as a fraction of your estate rather than a cash sum. Therefore they usually maintain their value or increase over time.

You may like to print this out and take it with you when visiting your solicitor to make or update your Will.

Legacy clause wording for England and Wales

I give all (or a share of) the residue of my estate absolutely to Self Help Africa of Second Floor Westgate House, Dickens Court, Off Hills Lane, Shrewsbury, SY1 1QU (Registered Charity Number 298830), to be applied by Self Help Africa for its charitable purposes.

I direct that the receipt of the Hon. Treasurer or any other proper officer of Self Help Africa for the time being shall be sufficient discharge to my executors.
